REGARDING

THE SECOND AMENDMENT ON THE MINISTER OF TRADE'S REGULATION NUMBER 10/M-DAG/PER/3/2009 REGARDING THE EXPORT OF GOODS WHICH IS OBLIGED TO USE LETTER OF CREDIT

BY THE GRACE OF ALLAH THE ONE SUPREME GOD THE MINISTER OF TRADE OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

Considering

- a. that in the context of expediting the acquiring of foreign exchange proceeds, it still requires a synchronization between the regulation on the flow of natural resourcesbased exported goods and the acquiring of foreign exchange from export proceeds, therefore it is required a re-adjustment to the provisions on the export of goods which is obliged to use Letter of Credit.
- that based on such consideration as referred to in letter and letter a, it needs to stipulate a Regulation of Minister of Trade

HAS DECIDED:

REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF TRADE' REGARDING

REGARDING THE EXPORT OF GOODS WHICH IS OBLIGED
TO USE LETTER OF CREDIT

Article I

Some of provisions in the Regulation of Minister of Trade Number 10/M-DAG/PER/3/2009 regarding the export of goods which is obliged to use Letter of Credit as amended by the Regulation of the Minister of Trade number 38/M-DAG/PER/8/2009, are amended as follows:

The provisions in article 5 are amended, therefore Article
 runs as follows:

Article 5

- (1) Exporter who conducts such export of goods as referred to in Article 1 is obliged to submit the Report on Export Realization and The Report on The Receiving of Export proceeds each month completely and correctly to the Minister of Trade in this matter the Director General of Foreign Trade.
- (2) Such Report on Export Realization as referred to in section (1) shall be submitted for both realized and unrealized exports.
- (3) Such Report on the Receiving of Export Proceeds as referred to in section (1) shall be submitted for both realized and unrealized receiving of export proceeds.
- (4) Report on Export Realization as referred to in section(1) as contained in Attachment II to this Regulation of the Minister, shall at least contain:
 - a. company identity;
 - b. date and number of PEB;
 - c. export volume;
 - d. the Free on Board (FOB) value;
 - e. method of payment; and;
 - f. account number and the name and address of the Domestic Foreign exchange Bank which

receives the export proceeds.

- (5) Report on the Receiving of Export Proceeds as referred to in section (1) as contained in Attachment III to this Regulation of the Minister, shall at least contain:
 - a. company identity;
 - b. date and number of PEB;
 - c. amount of export proceeds receipt; and
 - d. number of export proceeds receipt.
- (6) Such Report on Export Realization and Report on the Receiving of Export Proceeds as referred to in section (1) shall be submitted at the latest on the 10th day of the next month through http://inatrade.depdag.co.id or by electronic mail at the address of: dir1-daglu@depdag.co.id for CPO, coffee, cocoa and rubber commodities, and dir2-daglu@depdag.co.id, for Mining Products.
- 2. The provisions in Article 7 are amended, therefore Article 7 runs as follows:

Article 7

- (1) The obligation to use L/C payment method through Domestic Foreign Exchange Bank for export of goods as referred to in Article 1 section (1) and the introduction of L/C number and date on PEB as referred to in Article 3 section (1) shall be in effect as of July 1, 2010.
- (2) Export of goods as referred to in section (1) may use L/C payment method or other methods of payment applicable in international trade commenced to be in effect back on September 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.
- (3) The obligation to include in PEB the L/C payment method as well as its number and date, or by other

methods of payment as well as the number and date of its document of payment if any, as referred to in article 3 section (2) commenced to be in effect back on April 1, 2009

3. The provisions in Article 8 are amended, therefore Article 8 runs as follows:

Article 8

Upon exporters who violate the provisions in Article 1 section (1), Article 2, Article 3, Article 5, and Article 7 it shall be imposed sanctions according to the provisions in statutory regulation.

4 The provisions in Article 9 are deleted.

Article II

This Regulation of the Minister shall be in effect as of its stipulation date.

In order to let everyone be aware of, instructing the enactment of this Regulation of the Minister by posting it in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
