**REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF TRADE OF THE REPUBLIC OF
INDONESIA
NUMBER 34/M-DAG/PER/6/2014
CONCERNING**

**ORGANIZATION AND WORK PROCEDURE
OF THE INDONESIAN TRADE SECURITY COMMITTEE**

**BY THE GRACE OF ALLAH THE ONE SUPREME GOD
THE MINISTER OF TRADE OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,**

- Considering : a. that in the framework of implementing the provision of Article 96 paragraph (3) of the Government Regulation Number 34 of 2011 concerning the Anti Dumping Action, Reward Action and Trade Security Action, and taking account of the Letter of Approval of the Minister of State Apparatus Empowerment and Bureaucracy Reformation Number B/1291/M.PAN-RB/3/2013 concerning Structuring of Non Structural Institution Organization (LNS) within the circles of structuring the Ministry of Trade, it is necessary to restructure the Organization and Work Procedure of the Indonesian Anti Dumping Committee;
- b. that based on the consideration as meant in letter a, it is necessary to enact the Regulation of the Minister of Trade.
- In view of : 1. Law Number 7 of 1994 concerning Ratification of Agreement Establishing the World Trade Organization, (State Gazette of

- the Republic of Indonesia Number 57 of 1994, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3564);
2. Law Number 10 of 1995 concerning Customs (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 75 of 1995, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3612) as already amended by virtue of Law Number 17 of 2006 (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 93 of 2006, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4661);
 3. Law Number 7 of 2014 concerning Trade (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia of 2014 Number 45, Supplement to the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5512);
 4. Government Regulation Number 34 of 2011 concerning Anti Dumping Action, Reward Action and Trade Security Action (State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia Number 5225);
 5. Presidential Decree Number 84/P of 2009 concerning United Indonesia Cabinet II, as has been amended with the Presidential Decree Number 8P of 2014;
 6. Presidential Regulation Number 47 of 2009 concerning Formation and Organization of the State Ministry, as has been amended several times and latest with the Presidential Regulation Number 13 of 2014;
 7. Regulation of the Minister of Trade Number 31/M-DAG/PER/7/2010 concerning Organization and Work Procedure of the Ministry of Trade , as has been amended with the Regulation of the Minister of Trade Number 57/M-DAG/PER/8/2012;

HAS DECIDED:

To stipulate : **THE REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF TRADE CONCERNING THE ORGANIZATION AND WORK PROCEDURE OF THE INDONESIAN TRADE SECURITY COMMITTEE.**

CHAPTER I

POSITION, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

Article 1

The Indonesian Trade Security Committee, hereinafter abbreviated KPPI (Komite Pengamanan Perdagangan Indonesia), is the Committee under the supervision of and responsible to the Minister of Trade.

Article 2

KPPI is assigned to handle problems related to the efforts to recover Serious Losses or to prevent Threat on Serious Losses suffered by the Domestic Industry as consequence of the surge of total import.

Article 3

In implementing the duties, as meant in Article 2, KPPI carries out the following functions:

- a. Conducts the investigation on Serious Losses or Threat on Serious Losses suffered by Similar Type of Domestic Industry or Goods that Directly Compete with Goods that are Investigated as consequence of the surge of total import;
- b. Collects, examines and processes evidences and information related to the investigation;
- c. Prepares reports on the result of investigation;
- d. Recommends the imposing of Security Action to the Minister;
and
- e. Implements other related duties assigned by the Minister.

CHAPTER II

ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE

Article 4

- (1) The organization structure of KPPI consists of:
 - a. Chairman;
 - b. Vice Chairman;
 - c. Secretariat;

d. Sub Committee of Investigation

- (2) The organization structure of KPPI, as meant in paragraph (1), is contained in the Appendix, which is an inseparable part of this Regulation of the Minister.

Article 5

The Chairman, as meant in Article 4 paragraph (1) letter a, is assigned to manage KPPI in implementing its duties and functions.

Article 6

- (1) The Vice Chairman, as meant Article 4 paragraph (1) letter b, is under the supervision of and responsible to the Chairman.
- (2) The Vice Chairman, as meant in paragraph (1), is assigned to assist the Chairman in managing the implementation of the duties and functions of KPPI.

Article 7

- (1) The Secretariat, as meant in Article 4 paragraph (1) letter c, is under the supervision of and responsible to the Chairman.
- (2) The Secretariat, as meant in paragraph (1), is ex officio implemented by the International Trade Advocacy Service Center, Secretariat General of the Ministry of Trade.

Article 8

The Secretariat is assigned to provide technical and administrative services to KPPI.

Article 9

In implementing the duties, as meant in Article 8, the Secretariat organizes the functions of:

- a. Drawing up the program and budget plans;
- b. Implements the administrative affairs of personnel, organization, correspondence and documentation;
- c. Implements the cooperation administration in the sector of

- KPPI strengthening and development;
- d. Implements the finances and state assets administrative affairs;
 - e. Implements the legal study, composition of the legislative regulation plan, and dissemination of information related to the investigation in the framework of imposing the Security Action; and
 - f. Implements the investigation administration in the framework of imposing the Security Action.

Article 10

- (1) The Sub Committee of Investigation, as meant in Article 4 letter d, is the executive element in the sector of investigation, which is under the supervision of and responsible to the Chairman.
- (2) The Sub Committee of Investigation consists of Professionals in their respective fields.
- (3) The Sub Committee of Investigation is managed by the Head of the Sub Committee of Investigation.

Article 11

The Sub Committee of Investigation consists of:

- a. Sub Committee of Investigation in the Sector of Industry and Mining; and
- b. Sub Committee of Investigation in the Sector of Agriculture, Forestry, Marine and Fishery.

Article 12

- (1) The Sub Committee of Investigation in the Sector of Industry and Mining is assigned to search for evidences on the assumption of existing serious losses or threat on serious losses suffered by the Domestic Industry in the sector of industrial and mining products as consequence of surge in the total import of Goods Under Investigation.

- (2) The Sub Committee of Investigation in the sector of Agriculture, Forestry, Marine and Fishery is assigned to search for evidences on the assumption of existing serious losses or threat on serious losses suffered by the Domestic Industry in the sectors of agriculture, forestry, marine and fishery as consequence of surge in the total import of Goods Under Investigation.

Article 13

- (1) In implementing their respective duties, the Sub Committees of Investigation follow the procedure and method as well as code of ethics determined by the Chairman.
- (2) Each Sub Committee of Investigation consists of maximum 7 (seven) members.

CHAPTER III

FINANCING

Article 14

All costs that are needed for the implementation of duties and functions of KPPI are charged to the National Budget of the Ministry of Trade.

CHAPTER VI

WORK PROCEDURE

Article 15

In implementing its duties, each manager and official within the circles of KPPI is required to apply the principles of coordination, integration and synchronization, either within the circles of KPPI or with units within the circles of the Ministry of Trade and other related agencies.

Article 16

The managers and officials of KPPI are required to control their respective subordinates and in case of any existing deviation, to take

measures that are needed in accordance with the provisions of the legislative regulations.

Article 17

Each manager and official of KPPI is responsible to manage and coordinate its subordinates and to provide guidance and instructions for the implementation of the subordinates' duties.

Article 18

Each manager and official of KPPI is required to follow and obey the instructions and is responsible to their respective superiors and to submit reports.

Article 19

Each report that is received by the manager and official of KPPI from the subordinates is processed and used as material to draw up further reports and to provide instructions to the subordinates.

Article 20

In submitting reports to the superiors, it is also required to submit the copies to other units that have work relationship.

CHAPTER V

CLOSING

Article 21

Other provisions that are not regulated yet in this Regulation of the Minister, which are related to the Organization and Work Procedure of KPPI, are further determined by the Minister of Trade.

Article 22

At the time this Regulation of the Minister commences applicable, the Decree of the Minister of Trade and Industry Number 84 of 2003 concerning Indonesian Trade Security Committee is withdrawn and declared inapplicable.

Article 23

This Regulation of the Minister commences applicable on the date of enactment.

So that it is known by everyone, the enactment of this Regulation of the Minister is instructed with its placement in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
