# ASSIGNMENT TO THE GOVERNOR OR BUPATI/MAYOR IN THE FRAMEWORK OF IMPLEMENTING THE CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES OF THE DISTRIBUTION MEANS THAT IS FUNDED THROUGH THE ASSISTANCE DUTY FUND OF THE NATIONAL BUDGET OF FISCAL YEAR 2014

#### **UPON GRACE OF THE ONLY GOD**

#### THE MINISTER OF TRADE OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA,

Considering

- : a. that in the framework of implementing the Construction and Development of the Distribution Means that Funded through Assistance Duty Fund of the National Budget of Fiscal Year 2014 and in order to implement the provision of Article 3paragraph (1) of the Regulation of the Minister of Trade Number 42/M-DAG/PER/10/2010 concerning the Management of the Construction and |Development Activities of the Distribution Means through the Assistance Duty Fund;
  - b. that based on the consideration as meant in letter a, it

is necessary to enact the Regulation of the Minister of Trade concerning the Assignment to the Governor or Bupati/Mayor in the framework of Implementing the Activities of Construction and Development of the Distribution Means that is funded through the Assistance Duty Fund of the National Budget of Fiscal Year 2014.

#### HAS DECREED:

To enact

THE REGULATION OF THE MINISTER OF TRADE CONCERNING ASSIGNMENT TO THE GOVERNOR OR BUPATI/MAYOR IN THE FRAMEWORK OF IMPLEMENTING THE CONSTRUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES OF THE DISTRIBUTION MEANS THAT IS FUNDED THROUGH THE ASSISTANCE DUTY FUND OF THE NATIONAL BUDGET OF FISCAL YEAR 2014.

#### **Article 1**

- (1) This Regulation of the Minister of Trade is intended to be the basis for the Governor or Bupati/Mayor, who receives the assignment from the Minister of Trade to implement the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means that is funded through the Assistance Duty Fund of the National Budget of Fiscal Year 2014
- (2) The Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means are intended to accelerate the fluency of the flow of goods, maintain the availability of the basic needs of the community, maintain the price stability, realize the clean, healthy (hygienic), safe, orderly market and comfortable public space, improve the business opportunities, and enhance the contribution of the trade sector toward the regional economy.

#### Article 2

(1) The Minister of Trade assigns the Governor or Bupati/Mayor to implement the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means that is funded through the Assistance Duty Fund of the National Budget of Fiscal Year 2014, as indicated in Appendix I, which is an inseparable part of this Regulation of the Minister.

- (2) The Governor or Bupati/Mayor is fully responsible for the implementation of assignment, as meant in paragraph (1), either physically or administratively.
- (3) The assignment to implement the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means, as meant in paragraph (1), may not be transferred to another party.
- (4) The Governor or Bupati/Mayor, as meant in paragraph (1), submits the proposal for the financial management official of the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means, which is then determined by the Minister.
- (5) The Governor or Bupati/Mayor is not allowed to propose the change of the Financial Management Official for the implementation of the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means, unless the concerned is permanently hindered and no more complies with the conditions.
- (6) In the implementation of the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means, the Governor or Bupati/Mayor should:
- a. Implement the duties of the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means, as meant in paragraph (1), as good as possible until completion, maximum within the period of 1 (one) fiscal year;
- b. Carry out the guidance and control in order to prevent the occurrence of all forms of violation that may obstruct the

implementation of activities:

- Carry out the guidance so that the operation results of the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means may provide the impact of performance improvement;
- d. Keep and maintain the results Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution Means after completion of the development activities;
- e. Report the implementation of the Construction and Development Activities to the Minister in accordance with the provisions of the legislative regulations.

#### **Article 3**

Prior to the implementation of the Construction and Development Activities of the Distribution \means, the Governor or Bupati/Mayor should sign the Agreement of Integrity, as indicated in Appendix II, which is an inseparable part of this Regulation of the Minister.

#### **Article 4**

This Regulation of the Minister commences effective on the date of its enactment. So that it is known by everyone, the enactment of this Regulation of the Minister is instructed with its placement in the State Gazette of the Republic of Indonesia.
